How can I help?

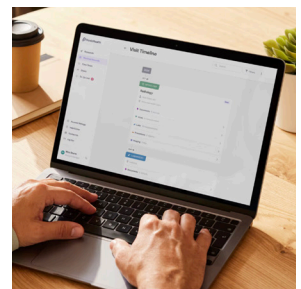
It's easy. Take 10 minutes to join the registry and link your records to help researchers have more data to include in their analysis. This will help advance CAH research, including:

Frequently Asked Questions

Who qualifies to participate?

Anyone who has been diagnosed with classic congenital adrenal hyperplasia (CAH) and lives in the U.S. is eligible to participate, including both adults and children.

How does sharing medical records help with research?

Medical records track every detail of a doctor/patient visit, which provides helpful information on how care has been delivered. They also contain information about symptoms, health status and treatments. Putting all this information together for a group of people allows researchers to see patterns that no one doctor can see on his/her own.

Who is PicnicHealth?

Will I see the registry results?

Yes! The CAHtalog® Registry will make every effort to share published results back with you.

Can I delete my medical records from PicnicHealth?

You may choose to delete your medical records from the PicnicHealth service at any time and for any reason. Just email PicnicHealth at help@picnichealth.com. However, any data that has already been shared with a research partner, up until the time you notify PicnicHealth to stop participating in research, cannot be changed or deleted.
